

#### It's Time for School Kits for MCC

Notebooks and pencils are treasures for families who struggle to afford basic school supplies. School kits are often requested after disasters and help bring normalcy to children whose families have been forced to flee their homes. According to MCC "78,035" were shipped last year to Jordan, Bosnia, and Herzegovina, Iraq, Zambia, Ukraine, Somalia, Burkina Faso, Canada, the U.S."

Eden will be collecting School Kits during August and September. There is a display in the fellowship hall where you can pick up a bag that Mary Martha Circle members have made. Go shopping and fill the bags with the following items:

- 4 spiral or perforated-page notebooks (8.5 in x 10.5 in and 70 sheets)
- 8 new unsharpened pencils
- 1 ruler (flat, good quality; must indicate 30cm; inch markings optional, may be plastic or wooden)
- 12 colored pencils (in packaging)
- 1 large eraser
- 2 new black or blue ballpoint pens

Mary Martha will add a small metal pencil sharpener to each kit since they are hard to find.

Return the filled bags to church and put them in boxes by the display. Let's see how many School Kits we can collect. We will post on the board how many kits come in. If you prefer to just purchase certain items just put them in the boxes. If you prefer to donate cash, just take a check to the church office and items will be purchased and placed in bags.
