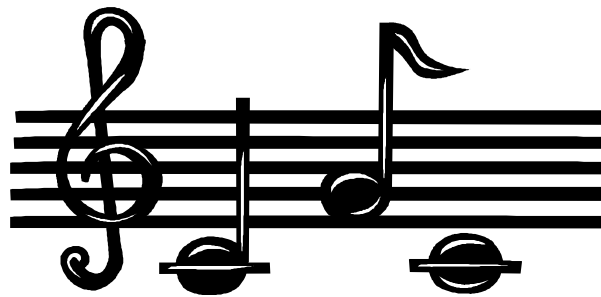

Explanation:

A symphony is a complex musical arrangement that typically includes several movements. These movements are each separate pieces within the symphony, yet are all intricately tied to each other with common strands of notes and tunes. Each movement adds something consistent and yet more complex to the entirety of the symphony. The Bible can be understood according to the metaphor of a symphony. As you read, notice the various movements that you experience and how those movements are consistent with the whole scope of the Bible and how they add depth and complexity.

1. **The movement of God**
2. **The movement of humans.**
3. **How the scripture moves you.**
