Our guest speaker this morning is Dr. Joseph Manickam. Joe Manickam, Ph.D was born in Chiang Mai, Thailand to missionary parents from the Church of South India. Joe encountered an Anabaptist perspective for the first time when he attended Hesston College and later Goshen College. His studies took him to Fuller Theological Seminary where he completed his Ph.D in Intercultural Studies. Joe has served in leadership roles with the Center for Anabaptist Leadership in Pasadena, Ca., MCC as the Director of MCC's Asia program, and with the Institute of Religion, Culture and Peace at Payap University in Chaing Mai, Thailand. Joe is married to Wanda, and they have two children: Faith and Matthew.

Adult Salt & Light Bible Study: Habakkuk, unlike most of the other prophets, does not speak God's Word *to us* but rather speaks our word *to God*. Habakkuk gives voice to our bewilderment and disappointment when we cry out, "God, you don't seem to make sense!" In particular, Habakkuk asks why God allows the evil empire of Babylon to destroy the nation of Judah. God's answer is simply that "the righteous live by their faith" (2:4) and "that arrogant do not endure." (2:5) The prophet then lists a series of five woes against the arrogant for their greed, violence, false security, exploitation, and idolatry. We must examine what idols are taking the place of God in our lives and make space to receive the sacred by cutting out that which is hindering us. Check out this short video from Jacob Lee.
