"On May 1, we will be conducting a routine Pastoral review for Pastors Derek and Dianne. Kevin Wilder from WDC will facilitate the review, and will be present with us on Sunday, May 1. Paper copies of the review will be handed out in Church on May 1 and will be able to be returned for the next 2 weeks to the fellowship hall. Here is where the church budget stands at the end of the first quarter: Giving is down approximately \$14,000 and expenses are up \$34,000. There were some extraordinary expenses in the first quarter. We paid for window repairs of \$12,000, boiler repairs of \$9,000, final payment on the roof of \$2,000, and \$9,000 for new hymnals. The funds to pay for the entire cost of the hymnals were received in 2021.

Our denomination, Mennonite Church USA, is holding a **Special Delegate Assembly** May 27-30, the purpose of which is to discuss and discern the voice of the Spirit concerning major issues of policy. There are **four important resolutions** that will be discussed at that time. Eden Leadership Team is sending Berni Kaufman, Jay Goering, Dianne Schmidt, and Derek King as delegates to the assembly. To help the delegates represent Eden, there will be opportunities on May 15 and 22 for you to **respond to the resolutions in the presence of the delegates**. Details will follow shortly. We expect anyone who would like to participate in this process **familiarize yourself with the resolutions**.
