She spent five years in the Palestine-Israel region coordinating peace and justice immersive experiences for North American young adults. During this period, she also volunteered with the Bethlehem Bible College in Bethlehem, Palestine, serving as the English Communications Officer in the Development Department. She has also studied peace and conflict resolution in several other countries. Keren has served as a Peace Associate at the Lombard Mennonite Peace Center outside of Chicago. Most recently, Keren served in an administrative role with the Chicagoland Trauma-Informed Congregations Network before joining KIPCOR in December, 2024. Keren earned a Bachelors degree in International Relations from Indiana Wesleyan University. She also earned a Master's of Conflict Transformation degree from Eastern Mennonite University and holds a Graduate Certificate in Faith-Based Peacebuilding from Eastern Mennonite Seminary.
